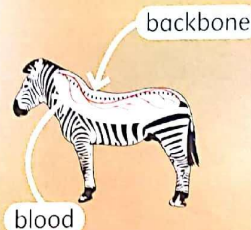
Point to the lion, the bat and the dolphin. Which are mammals?

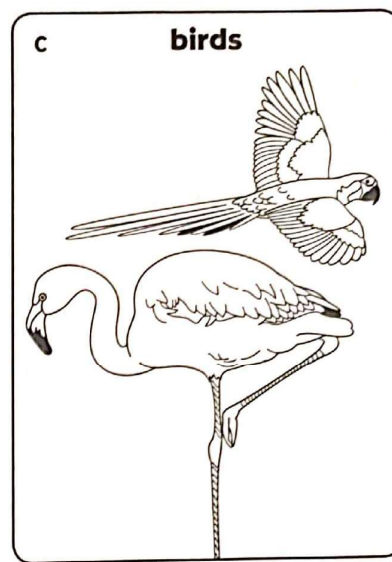
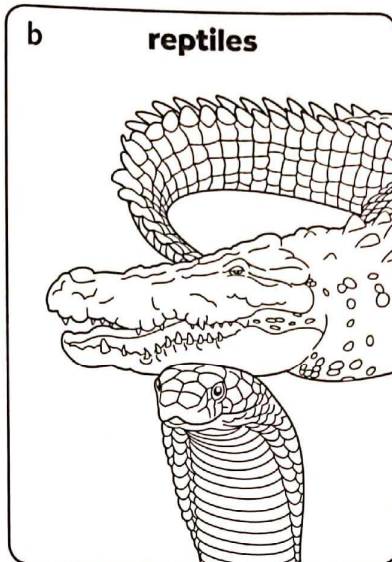
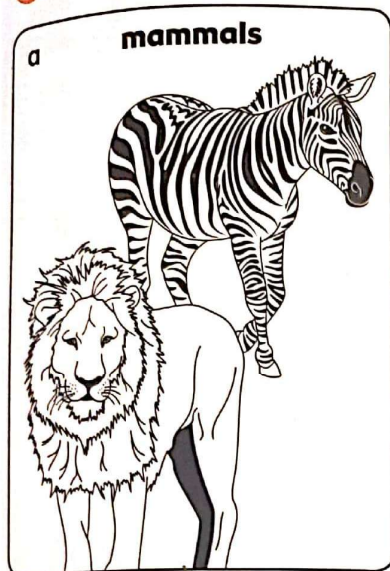
